

**MURRAY STATE UNIVERSITY
ENDOWMENT MATCH PROGRAM
2012-2013 Summary Report**

This report summarizes the programmatic and financial results of the Endowment Match Program at Murray State University during Fiscal Year 2012-13.

Murray State has received all of its state matching funds. During 2012-13, Murray State received additional private matching funds of \$10,000 leaving only \$7,831 in pledged funds still outstanding. Since the inception of the program in 1998, Murray State has received \$10,070,787 in state matching funds and \$10,062,956 in private matching funds for a total endowment increase of \$20,133,743.

Endowment activity

With these endowment funds, the University has been able to establish two endowed chairs and five endowed professorships. Both chairs and four of the professorships were

filled. The financial results of the program are as follows:
